

5 WAYS YOU WON'T GET PLAYED BY FAKE CLINICS:

1 CHECK THE PRO-TRUTH MAP

Go to www.protruthny.org to find a map of real women's healthcare providers and fake clinics

2 MAKE SURE YOU'RE IN THE RIGHT OFFICE

Fake clinics often trick patients by using similar names, or opening up across the street or even in the same building.

3 WATCH OUT FOR LIES

Fake clinics attempt to warn you of false or exaggerated risks of abortion, but abortion is very safe. It does not cause breast cancer or infertility.

4 READ THE SIGNS

In New York City, fake clinics are required by law to post a sign explaining that they do not have a licensed medical provider on site. But not all fake clinics have these signs, so be sure to ask for the truth!

5 ASK FOR THE TRUTH

Ask: "Do you offer abortion services or abortion referrals?" If the answer is anything but an absolute and immediate "yes," then you are at a fake clinic.
